## WELCOME TO GEORGIA, WINE AND DINE IN KAKHETI

Gamarjoba and welcome to Georgia! Often mistaken for a state in the US, this Georgia nestled between Europe and Asia, is known for its stunning Caucasus mountain landscapes, ancient wine-making traditions, and warm hospitality. It offers visitors a unique blend of vibrant cities, rustic villages, and scenic countryside, which we will duly and fully experience over the next couple of days.

Straight from the airport, we head out to the cradle of wine in Georgia, the Kakheti region. Learn about Georgia's proud wine heritage and their novel technique centered on qvevris (an egg-shaped clay vessel). Your first taste of Georgian food is best experienced at a family-run winery, where traditional recipes and locally sourced ingredients bring authentic flavors to life. Expect full tables today, and quite possibly, every other day to come!

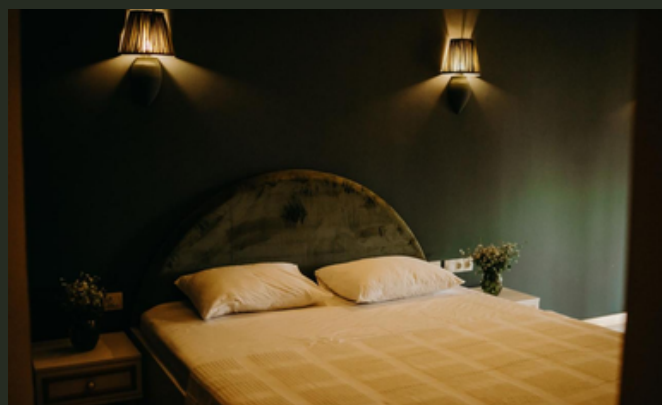
### MORE WINE TASTING IN VINEYARDS, SIGNAGHI - THE CITY OF LOVE

In the morning we are taking part in our first masterclass to make puri (traditional bread). Pay attention to the technique and skills needed to fire it up in the age-old tone (a deep circular clay oven).

Start the day courageously at our second winery by trying the owner's homemade cha-cha (a special spirit distilled from grape pomace). Enjoy a home-cooked supra (feast) for lunch paired with an award winning selection of natural amber and red wines using endemic grapes grown in this region.

After lunch, we make our way to the romantic town of Signaghi, where you'll have the chance to walk on the famous 18th-century walls surrounding the historic fortress and enjoy sweeping views of the Alazani Valley.

## NEKRESI MONASTERY, TRADITIONAL MASTERCLASSES, GRAPE HARVEST, WINE AND DINE

Recharge in nature, waking up to the beautiful views of the winery and a scrumptious breakfast with ingredients from the estate grounds. Thereafter, we visit Nekresi Monastery, a beautiful Georgian Orthodox monastery perched on the Caucasus mountain range.

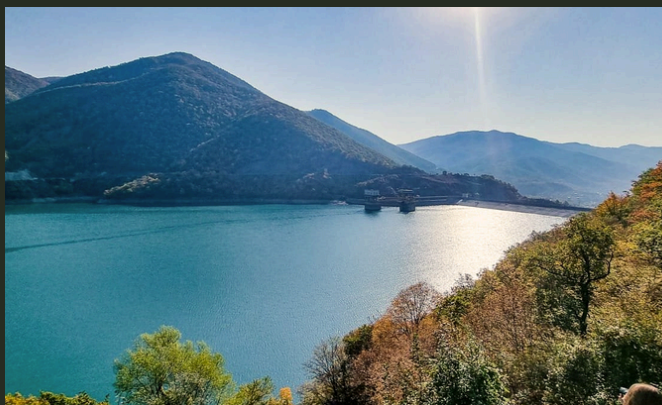
Roll up your sleeves in the afternoon and test your culinary aptitude folding khinkalis (traditional dumplings) and making churchkela (local nut snack). You'll also have the chance to pluck the tastiest tomatoes for a farm to table salad you'll make.

After lunch, it's time for the much anticipated grape harvest. During this bucket list activity, learn about how wine was traditionally made (hint: you'll need both your hands and legs for this). In the evening, get ready for our final hoorah in Kakheti with an elaborate dinner and wine party.

## ZHINVALI RESERVOIR, ANANURI FORTRESS, GUDAURI, PARAGLIDING

In the morning we bid farewell to the Kakheti region and head to the highlands. Enroute, there are plenty of historical landmarks to stop by - Zhinvali Reservoir and Ananuri Fortress. The latter is the only well-preserved northern Caucasian-style watch tower in the south Caucasus region. Impressive architecture aside, during your walk abouts, learn about the nifty tricks Georgians employed to defend themselves in the past.

After lunch, we start our ascent to Gudauri which in the colder months transform into the country's favourite ski destination. Visit the colourful and striking friendship monument in Gudauri and learn about the interesting history behind its origin. Weather permitting, you may opt to paraglide here where you will get treated to an unparalleled ariel view of both the monument and the deep valleys that surround it.

## TRUSO VALLEY, TRUSO GORGE, KAZBEGI

Get ready to let the magic of Truso Valley enchant you. We start the journey with a 4x4 ride into the valley before we continue the rest of the journey on foot. You will be greeted with some of the most magical views along this trek, passing by picturesque valleys, an abandoned village, meandering rivers, and a few other surprises. Do also a lookout for natural travertine mineral springs which have turned some parts of the landscape to a charming rusty orange color with shades of white.

After our trek, on our final leg to Kazbegi, we will reach Jvari Pass at the highest point, which at over 2,000 meters provides breathtaking panoramic views of the Caucasus Mountains including Mount Kazbek.

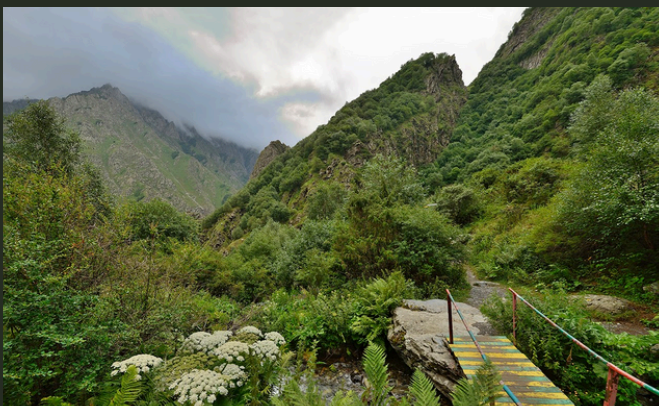
## ATV ADVENTURE, GVELETI WATERFALL HIKE, GERGETI TRINITY CHURCH, BBQ

After a quick refuel over lunch, we make our way to Gergeti Trinity Church. Its isolated location on top of a steep mountain surrounded by the vastness of nature has made it a symbol for Georgia. Enjoy unblocked panoramic views of the town and the mountain range.

There's no better way to conclude the day than with a BBQ dinner in the outdoors by our cabins - blending adventure, nature, and a delicious meal for an unforgettable experience.

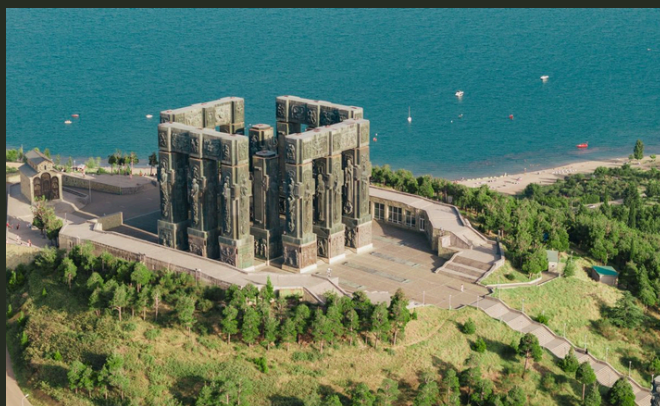
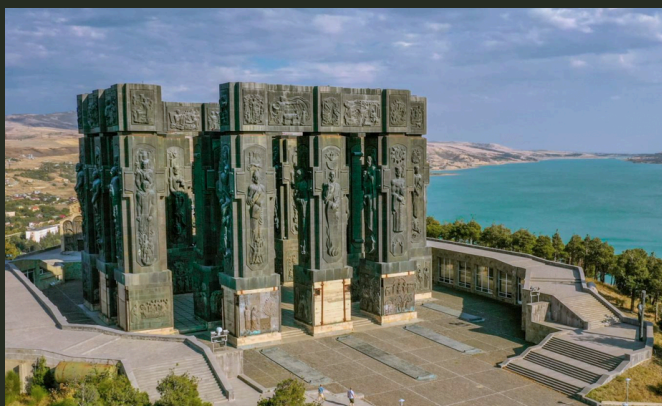
## MTSKHETA, JVARI MONASTERY, CHRONICLES OF GEORGIA, TBILISI

It is our last morning in the mountains, but the start of our next chapter in Georgia's vibrant capital city. Enroute to Tbilisi, we will stop by the old capital of Georgia, Mtskheta, famous for two UNESCO heritage sites — Svetitskhoveli Cathedral and Jvari Monastery. While the capital later shifted, Mtskheta remains a vital historical and religious center in the country.

We will also visit the Chronicles of Georgia, sometimes referred to as the 'Stonehenge of Tbilisi', which even be spotted on your flight in. This gigantic, modern sculpture consists of a series of towering stone pillars arranged in a circular pattern, each featuring large sculpted figures representing different historical and mythological figures from Georgia's history.

In the evening, we explore a popular local brewery famous for its hip, laid-back atmosphere. You'll get the first taste of Tbilisi's growing craft beer scene showcasing Georgian flavours.

Get a crash course of the cities history, culture, and landmarks with a historical walking tour in the old quarters. A cable car ride up to visit the Mother of Georgia, creates for the perfect setting the enjoy a panoramic view overlooking the entire city. Learn about how Tbilisi got its name, along with other interesting facts about the city's past.

**For large groups:** we might be able to give you an inside look at the leaders in a new wave of Georgian craft brews and sample brews straight from the vats. Expect a no-holds-barred approach to creativity inspired by local ingredients and traditional wine making techniques.

For our last dinner, we've planned a special meal in collaboration with one of the fast rising restaurants in Tbilisi serving their take on modern Georgian cuisine. Thereafter, head over to Fabrika, a former soviet sewing factory, to experience a slice of Georgia's eclectic nightlife.

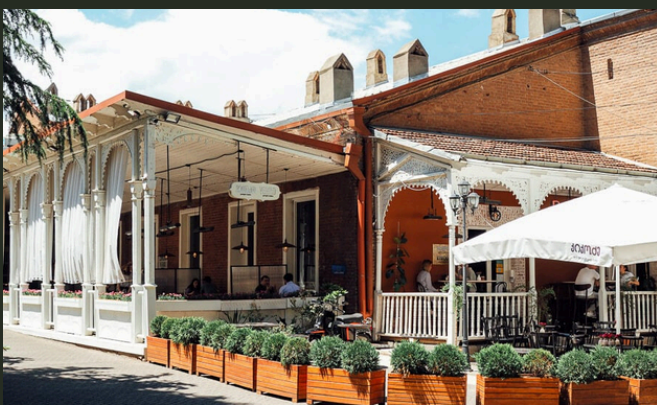

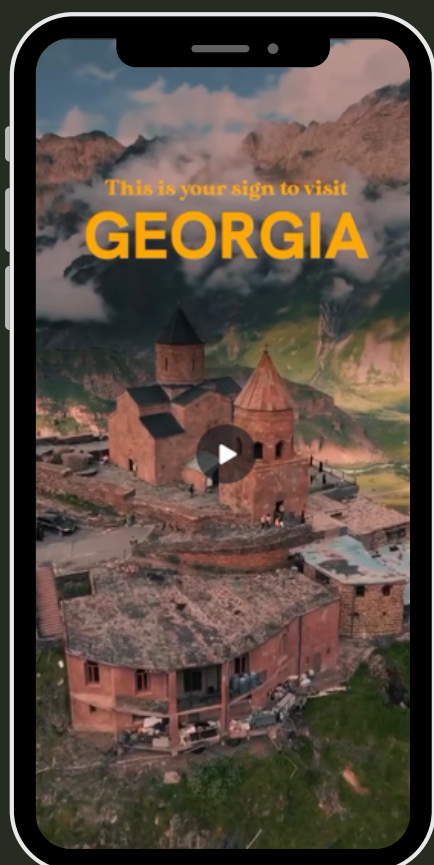

# Guide on Recommended Flights

Flight schedules do change, so please treat this as an indicative guide. We have also left out specific timings because they vary across the year. Generally when recommending flights, we consider the following:

- Number of layovers
- Total duration (flying time + layover time)
- Arrival and departure timings
- Reliability and comfort of the carrier
- Price

Additionally, when planning our trips, we will usually look to minimize the number of leave days required and plan flights to include back to back weekends. In order to do this well, we first need to understand which days of the week the flight operates.
