ARRIVAL & WINE COUNTRY WELCOME IN KAKHETI

Gamarjoba (hello) and welcome to Georgia; known for its breathtaking Caucasus landscapes, ancient wine-making traditions, and unmatched hospitality. Over the next few days, you'll discover vibrant cities, rustic villages, and the heart of Georgian culture. From the airport, we journey straight to Kakheti, the cradle of wine. Here, you'll learn about Georgia's proud heritage and its unique qvevri winemaking method, practiced for over 8,000 years. At a family-run winery, we enjoy our first tasting with wines paired with local cheeses, warm bread dipped in fragrant sunflower oil, and spice blends that capture the essence of the region.

The highlight of the day is a traditional Supra, Georgia's legendary feast. Expect tables overflowing with dishes, heartfelt toasts led by the appointed toastmaster, and the joyful atmosphere of folk music. As the evening unfolds, you'll even have the chance to join in the fun and learn a few Georgian dance moves. A fittingly memorable start to your journey.

BREAD MAKING, WINE TASTING & SIGNAGHI

The day begins with a hands-on masterclass to make shoti, Georgia's traditional bread. Learn the technique behind firing it in a tone, the deep clay oven still used in homes today.

We then join a tour of a family winery, guided by Beka, a young but award-winning winemaker. He'll share the art of winemaking and fascinating details about how qvevris — the giant clay vessels — are buried underground to ferment and store the wines. Lunch is another homemade feast, paired with Beka's wines made from endemic Georgian grapes. The afternoon ends on a bold note with a shot of chacha, the fiery spirit distilled from grape pomace.

Later we continue to the romantic hilltop town of Signaghi, where you can stroll along 18th-century fortress walls and take in sweeping views of the Alazani Valley.

HANDS-ON MASTERCLASSES & GRAPE HARVEST

Put on your farming hats for today, we dive into Georgia's rich earth-to-table traditions. After breakfast, we head out to the fields to harvest fresh ingredients for Georgia's beloved tomato-and-cucumber salad. Next, roll up your sleeves to fold khinkali dumplings for lunch and string together churchkela, the classic walnut-and-grape must snack.

Then comes the highlight of the season: the grape harvest. Hand-pick bunches straight from the vines, sneak in a few sweet bites, and sip freshly pressed grape juice before stomping grapes the traditional way.

The afternoon is yours to unwind on the estate. Take a dip in the pool, wander the grounds, or capture golden-hour photos in one of the many picturesque spots. Dinner rounds off the day with a creative twist from the estate's kitchen, showcasing Georgia's produce in fresh ways and, of course, paired with estate wines.

MOUNTAIN DRIVE, HISTORIC FORTRESSES, OPTIONAL PARAGLIDING & INTO THE HIGHLANDS

This morning we bid farewell to Kakheti and begin our journey into Georgia's highlands. Along the way we stop at Zhinvali Reservoir and the Ananuri Fortress, the best-preserved northern Caucasian–style watchtower in the region. Beyond its impressive architecture, you'll hear fascinating stories of the clever defensive methods once used here.

After lunch, we continue the ascent to Gudauri, which in winter transforms into Georgia's most popular ski resort. Here we pause at the colourful Friendship Monument, a striking landmark with a history as layered as its mosaics.

For those seeking a thrill, paragliding is available (350 GEL including GoPro footage), offering an unparalleled view of the valleys and peaks below — a memory that stays long after your feet touch the ground.

TRUSO VALLEY TREK TO HISTORICAL ABANDONED VILLAGES & KAZBEGI

Get ready to let the magic of Truso Valley enchant you. We begin with a 4x4 ride into the valley before continuing on foot. The trek reveals some of the most beautiful scenery in the Caucasus with wide valleys, meandering rivers, abandoned villages, and landscapes touched by travertine mineral springs, where iron-rich waters have stained the earth in striking shades of orange and white.

After the hike, we continue our journey north. The drive offers sweeping views of mountains and valleys before bringing us to Kazbegi (Stepantsminda), a beloved hiking town in the summer months. Here, the dramatic silhouette of Mount Kazbek and its glacier dominate the skyline. Dinner is a homecooked feast by Grandma Maia. With recipes passed down through generations, her cooking is as comforting as it is flavourful, the perfect welcome to the highlands.

Accommodation: Boutique hotel or cabins in Kazbegi













ATV ADVENTURE, GVELETI WATERFALL HIKE, GERGETI TRINITY CHURCH & MOUNTAIN BBQ

We begin the day riding ATVs through pine forest trails, weaving between the trees before emerging at incredible viewpoints that open up to the vast Kazbegi landscape.

Next, we set off on a scenic hike to Gveleti Waterfall. The route begins on easy ground before climbing steeper toward the end. It's a manageable challenge with sturdy shoes, and the reward is a dramatic waterfall hidden in the quiet of the mountains.

In the afternoon, we visit the iconic Gergeti Trinity Church, perched high above Stepantsminda with Mount Kazbek rising behind it. Beyond its breathtaking setting, the church is a powerful symbol of Georgia's faith and resilience. Our final evening in the mountains is spent over dinner, followed by time under the stars. A peaceful close to our Kazbegi journey.

MTSKHETA, HILLTOP MONASTERIES & WELCOME TO TBILISI

We leave the mountains behind and journey toward Georgia's historic and modern capitals. Our first stop is Mtskheta, the country's spiritual heart and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Here we visit Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, where Georgian kings were crowned and buried, and Jvari Monastery, perched above the confluence of two rivers with a view that has inspired pilgrims for centuries.

Before reaching Tbilisi, we pause at the Chronicles of Georgia, a monumental hilltop complex of sculpted columns depicting the nation's kings, saints, and Christian heritage.

By evening, we arrive in Tbilisi, Georgia's bustling capital. The city brims with energy, from leafy boulevards and vibrant street art to a thriving food and wine scene. For those keen to explore after dark, Tbilisi's nightlife has plenty to offer, with natural wine bars, inventive cocktail spots, and the iconic Fabrika, a lively hub for both locals and travelers.

OLD TOWN WALKING TOUR, SULFUR BATHS, FREE AND EASY AFTERNOON, FINAL DINNER

We begin with a walking tour through Tbilisi's old town, its cobbled streets, colorful balconies, and historic churches. A cable car ride takes us to the Mother of Georgia, where you'll learn the story behind her sword and cup of wine, before enjoying panoramic city views. Back in town, we visit the sulfur baths that gave Tbilisi its name, and see landmarks like the striking Peace Bridge.

After lunch, the afternoon is yours. Explore museums, cafés, or boutiques, or book a soak and traditional kisa massage in one of the historic bathhouses (our guides can help, with Gulo's a popular choice).

In the evening, we gather for a final celebratory dinner at one of Tbilisi's up-and-coming restaurants. Here, creativity shines through both the flavors on the plate and the character of the space. A fitting finale to our Georgian journey.

FREE AND EASY MORNING, DEPARTURE

Based on our recommended flights, we'll need to leave the hotel before noon, but the morning is yours to enjoy at leisure.

You may choose to sleep in and slowly pack away your treasures, whether it's bottles of wine, jars of honey, fragrant tea, or playful socks with Georgian motifs that will remind you of the journey. If you prefer to head out, spend your final hours soaking up the city's atmosphere. Enjoy a coffee at a local café, or make a last stop at Dezerter Bazar or the more modern Orbeliani Market for souvenirs and snacks to bring home.

By midday, we transfer to the airport, carrying with us the flavors, stories, and memories of Georgia: a journey filled with warm hospitality, beautiful landscapes, and new connections. 
